I have been in the UK for the last couple of weeks at a variety of places including a funeral, a retreat, some time volunteering on a railway and some diocesan meetings. Luckily, I have a SatNav to help me find my way, but even with that, it's important to know your destination before start out. I was thinking about this as I read today's Gospel when Thomas asks: "Lord, we do not know where you are going, so how can we know the way?"

Jesus is much better than a SatNav. He not only shows us the way, He <u>is</u> the Way and He tells us where we are going. And like the SatNav, when we take a wrong turn in life, He always gives us a new route to Our Father in Heaven.

In today's first reading we see some tension between the Greek and Hebrew speakers over the distribution of food. The Twelve can no longer do all the preaching and other daily tasks so they decide that Seven others should be chosen to look after the distribution of food. Interestingly, of the Seven, at least two – Stephen and Philip – were also great preachers.

It isn't that surprising that I relate to this reading. The Seven were chosen primarily for service, but also to preach and assist the Twelve. The first Deacons. The Apostles prayed and laid hands on them, just as the Bishop prayed and laid hands on Alan and I at our Ordinations.

To me there is something deeper here as well. The Apostles knew that spreading God's word was important, but so was looking after the needy. We come to church to meet as a community, hear God's word and be nourished by the Eucharist but we must then go out and practice the Gospel by our actions.
