#### Do not be afraid.

As I read today's readings, the phrase that jumped out was "Do not be afraid" and as is my way I started singing the hymn of that title. There is a popular myth that the phrase "Do not be afraid" appears 365 times in the bible, one for every day. Unfortunately, there are actually only about 150 occurrences, but that's still a lot and gives us an indication of how important that message is.

It offers us hope, strength and courage when we are in doubt or struggling in any way. When Mary was called and chosen to be the mother of Jesus, she was deeply disturbed and wondered what the message meant. Immediately she was encouraged with the words, "Mary, do not be afraid". When Joseph heard that Mary was pregnant he was going to divorce her informally. But in a dream he had, he too heard these word, "Joseph, do not be afraid". In each experience God called Mary and Joseph by their names and asked them to take on what seemed like an impossible task. But having been called, they were not to rely on their own strength and determination; God who called them would also strengthen, support and encourage them. They would never be alone.

Like Mary and Joseph each of us is called by name by God. We are called to be examples and witnesses of Jesus in our world today. In today's gospel, Jesus asks us to declare ourselves for him in the presence of others. This can be difficult and challenging. The values of the gospel are not the values of the world. Through the quality of our daily lives, we are to be witnesses to Jesus and his gospel. We won't be left on our own, Jesus will be with us.

Let us not be afraid of what is being asked of us. Let us not be paralysed by our fear. Instead, let the words of Pope Francis encourage us, "go out again and again, without fear and proclaim the good news which is for all people".

Do not be afraid, For I have redeemed you.

I have called you be your name; you are mine.
