Do you remember scenes in cartoons such as Bugs Bunny where the character runs off the side of a cliff and happily keeps running in mid air until he realises that is what he's doing, and as soon as he realises, he drops to the ground.

I must admit that every time I read today's Gospel passage I picture such a scene. Peter has enough faith in Jesus to get out of the boat and start walking across the water. But as soon as he realises what is happening, he starts to sink.

This passage is a bit like a summary of Peter's Ministry. He starts out boldly with great confidence —for instance when Jesus asks who they say he is, Peter says: "You are the Messiah, the Son of the living God." Then things get tough and Peter is afraid of the forces against him — for instance when as Jesus said Peter would, he denies Jesus three times after he was arrested. But ultimately Peter is pulled through by the helping grace of God in whom he trusts — and Jesus, post resurrection, confirms Peter as the head of His church on earth when three times he asks Peter whether he loves Him and when Peter says yes, he is asked to look after the flock and feed them the Good News.

Our lives can be a bit like that. It is easy to start out with good intentions trusting God. But then, when things get tough, we forget God and try to go it alone leading to us sinking. But God will always hold out his hand to us and, provided we take it, he will see that all is right.

So instead of cartoon characters going over cliffs, let us try to picture the wonderful window in St. Anthony's in Onchan with Christ walking across the water towards us. In response, we hold out our hands and say "Yes, Lord, I trust you."
