The Transfiguration

Today we celebrate the Transfiguration of Jesus. What does that mean to us? Well, that event, a factual occurrence in history, was witnessed by Jesus' close friends, as he journeyed through Galilee toward his ultimate destination, his calling, his completion of the promises contained in Scripture. Initially, he told the disciples who witnessed it not to tell what they saw until his mission was complete – by his Resurrection – life affirmation, true life, everlasting life. The Transfiguration was confirmation to Jesus, but also to us, of Jesus' message of God's love for each and every one of us. God the Father's affirmation of Jesus; of his message, his words and actions; of our redemption; of our everlasting life, if we want it, if we accept his gift, his call. Jesus, in his humanity, had to learn about his calling and when he did, he accepted it, he put his faith into action. Proof of that calling was in what he experienced and his friends witnessed at his Transfiguration, celebrated today.

We are all called by God. We are all on our own individual journeys of faith, our transfiguration. Let us not worry about our failings and failures. Peter is a good example of someone who stumbled along and then found his own transfiguration in faith. Our transfiguration in faith may not be as dramatic as what happened to Jesus and his friends witnessed but, through and on our own journeys, we experience the light of Life; the love of God, through Jesus, in the Spirit, as we journey toward the promise of everlasting life.

Let us rejoice in the message of the Transfiguration of Jesus. He is the light of the world.
