Dear Parishioners

This Saturday evening, 9th September, we welcome the **Reverend Phil Jump**, Regional Minister of the North West Baptist Association – of which the Isle of Man forms a part. Phil is visiting Broadway Baptist Church over the weekend. I worked closely with Phil for many years in my ecumenical role as Churches' Officer for the North West. Phil was chair of my management group. **He has kindly agreed to preach at our 5.00pm Mass at St Mary's this weekend**. I look forward to catching up with him.

Our Parish Council for St Mary of the Isle & St Joseph and St Anthony of Padua met again this week. Among items discussed were the Douglas City Council Civic Service being held for the first time in St Mary's Church on Sunday 24th September. Civic leaders, both officers and elected members, will be joining us at the 11.00am Mass. There was also an update on Archbishop Malcolm's visit to the Island on the weekend of 30th September for an official visitation to Castletown and Port Erin. He will also be celebrating the Sacrament of Confirmation for young people across the Island at St Mary of the Isle at 11.00am on Saturday 30th. The meeting addressed the pending retirement of Bishop Peter Eagles, Bishop of Sodor and Man. Bishop Peter will be leading the third day of our Novena to Mary Untier of Knots on Thursday 5th October. This will also give us the opportunity to say our own goodbyes to Bishop Peter. Members discussed the Assisted Dying Bill beginning its progress through Tynwald. We were reminded of the words of Dame Cecily Saunders, founder of the hospice movement: 'We do not hasten or postpone death'. It was agreed that parishioners be encouraged to write personally and individually to their MHKs to maximise our opposition to the Bill. Fr John thanked members of the Council for their contributions to our two parishes. 'Members aren't talkers but do-ers'. Each member is an active volunteer in some aspect of parish life.

'Sometimes it may seem to us that there is no purpose in our lives., that going day after day for years to this same office or that school or factory is nothing else but waste and weariness. But it may be that God has sent us there because but for us Christ would not be there. If our being there means that Christ is there, that alone makes it worthwhile'. (Caryll Houselander - The Reed of God, 1955)

'Above all the cross must be proclaimed by witness. Take a Christian or a handful of Christians who, in the midst of their own community, show their capacity for understanding and acceptance, their sharing of life and destiny with other people, their solidarity with the efforts of all for whatever is noble and good. Let us suppose that, in addition, they radiate an altogether simple and unaffected way their faith in values that go beyond current values, and their hope in something that is not seen and that one would not dare imagine. Through this wordless witness these Christians stir up irresistible questions in the hearts of those who see how they live. Why are they like this? Why do they live in this way? What or who is it that inspires them? Why are they in our midst? Such a witness is already a silent proclamation of the Good News and a very powerful and effective one.
