Good wishes from Rome !

I returned here on Sunday and we are now preparing for the arrival of our new seminarians on Friday – from England, Ireland, Sweden, India and the Philippines (so by the time you read this they will have begun their Induction fortnight). For the coming months we are also hosting the seminarians and staff of the Scottish College; they have left their 'old' college building on the outskirts of Rome and are looking for somewhere more central.

The coming weeks will be busy as we prepare for the SYNOD which will be held here in Rome during the month of October. We have become very familiar over these past months and years with the concept of Synods and synodality ---- it is all about **walking together, learning to listen more deeply** to the needs of others and to see how, in fidelity to the Gospel, we are able to be a voice of God's comfort and consolation in a world which can so often appear to be hard- hearted and self –centered.

Cardinal Vincent Nicols, Archbishop of Westminster, has written a pastoral message to his Diocese... but I'm sure he won't mind if we 'listen in' to his words....

'The purpose of the synod is not to produce more documents. Rather it is intended to inspire people to dream about the church we are called to be, to make hopes flourish, to stimulate trust, to bind up wounds, to weave new and deeper relationships, to learn from one another, to build bridges, to enlighten minds, warm hearts and restore strength to our hands for our common mission.'
