World Mission Sunday

"World Mission Sunday" falls on the penultimate Sunday in October, and is a day when we pray for missionary activity. This year, 2023, World Mission Sunday will be celebrated on Sunday, 22 October.

Donations are collected at these worldwide Masses, and they go, in their entirety, to support churches, hospitals, schools and vocations in countries where the Church is new, young, or poor.

World Mission Sunday is our chance to show love and solidarity to our brothers and sisters overseas who share our faith. In offering our prayers, we join with missionaries everywhere in communion and compassion to support them in spreading the Good News, and by giving a donation we respond to Christ's call to feed the hungry and clothe the naked.

Mission is responsible for coordinating World Mission Sunday and provides new, young, or poor dioceses with the essential support they need on their journey to becoming self-sufficient.

It works through local bishops, churches, and missionary congregations to ensure that resources are distributed equitably and justly – based on need. The money goes directly from England and Wales to the bishops in the mission territories – local Church directly helping local Church.

Today we have a second collection for Mission. Through our generous donations to Mission, we support all Catholic churches throughout the world.
