#### ADVENT SEASON

Advent is an important time of preparation and joyful expectations of the coming of Christ. Advent brings hope and encourages Christians to deepen their faith and trust in God's promises.

The word "Advent" stems from the Latin Word Adventus, which literally means "coming" or "arrival." This primarily refers to the first coming of Jesus on Christmas day which is the historical coming of Christ in the incarnation – Christ's birth at Bethlehem.

The second coming is the spiritual coming of Christ into the hearts of believers through the Sacraments, particularly through Baptism and the Holy Eucharist. In this spiritual coming Christ comes to dwell in the souls of the believers.

The third coming which is the final coming at the end of time (*porousia*), which we don't know the hour or the day. So, as people living in the meantime, we prepare ourselves to be ready with good deeds and works of mercy, our lamps full of oil (Matthew 25:4) and stay awake (Matthew 24:42). Today's opening prayer reflects this reality. "*Grant your faithful, we pray, almighty God, the resolve to run forth to meet your Christ with righteous deeds at his coming, so that, gathered at his right hand, they may be worthy to possess the heavenly Kingdom.*"

The first half of Advent the focus is on the *Parousia* which we profess in the Creed, "*He will come again in glory to judge the living and the dead*," and the second half from the 17<sup>th of</sup> December the focus is on His first coming at Christmas. We must be watchful and ready for these comings during this Advent Season.

Advent is a special season for prayer and conversion. All times are for prayer and conversion but in Advent we pray more, and the best preparation is to receive the Sacrament of reconciliation so that we turn to God with clean hearts. It is good to get involved in spiritual practices that can help us to grow closer to God, for example prayer, meditation, fasting and acts of charity.

In Advent Season, the Blessed Virgin Mary is our model; we learn her virtues: faith, obedience, humility, purity, prudence, devotedness, poverty, mercy, patience etc.

In summary, Advent is a time of joyful expectation and spiritual preparation of the coming of Christ, a period of hope for God's promises, prayer, conversion, and renewal during this special season in the Liturgical Year B.
