You may have seen Baroness Tanni Grey-Thompson (Paralympian and phenomenal disability rights campaigner) was on the Island recently to talk to MHKs. In November, MHKs voted to send the proposed bill to a Clauses Committee, which is due to report back at the end of this month.
