The Sacred Triduum begins with the Mass of the Lord's Supper on Maundy or Holy Thursday. Please note Mass times for both Parishes.

On Good Friday there is the traditional mandatory collection for the Holy Place.

Good Friday is a day of Fast and Abstinence, with Ash Wednesday the only such days in the year.

For those who follow this excellent devotion, the Divine Mercy Novena begins on Good Friday.

For the Easter Triduum, we have purchased sufficient copies of the Easter Triduum booklet (eighty seven pages). They are for use during the Triduum. They remain the property of the Parishes, so please treat them with care, as we hope to be able to use them also in future years.
