Archdiocesan Synodal Council 2023: Part 5 Becoming a Church that cares for its priests.

The inaugural synod identified this issue. The Pastoral Plan published in 2020 stated that the Archdiocese would take steps to enable its priests to flourish in changing situations. An externally facilitated process was set up to explore with the priests how to provide effective support for their flourishing in the various aspects of their lives. The facilitator listened to the priests and their experiences and produced a document that has been shared with them and with the Archdiocese. A group of priests, nominated by their peers, continued to meet, and reflect on the document and are looking at offering retreats and days of reflection. The Archdiocese intends to introduce mentoring and supervision as a right and duty of care for its priests and to set up structures to sustain the work of supporting priests and enabling them to flourish.

Although his topic was not discussed as part of the ASC, it was noted that priests are an essential resource and must be supported in terms of good employment practice. The lack of support provided previously was surprising and it was suggested that a safe space should be provided in which to discuss matters of mutual concern. The implementation of fundamental changes will affect everyone, not just the priests. We must all be aware of this, and support those who may find this unsettling.
