Vatican News

Pope Francis presided over a solemn event Monday at the Apostolic Palace in the Vatican commemorating the 40th anniversary of the Treaty of Peace and Friendship between Argentina and Chile that settled a border dispute between the two countries. The pontiff denounced the hypocrisy of some countries "where there is much talk of peace" but "the highest yielding investments are in the production of arms." This pharisaical attitude, he continued, always leads "to the failure of fraternity and peace. May the international community make the force of law prevail through dialogue, for dialogue "must be the soul of the international community." The agreement between Chile and Argentina resolved the crisis caused by a territorial dispute over the Beagle Channel and sovereignty over several islands. The Vatican played an essential role in this peace agreement.

In conclusion, Pope Francis described what is happening in Ukraine and Palestine as "two failures" of humanity today where the "arrogance of the invader prevails over dialogue.
